Course Guides

COURSE GUIDES

A guide shall be prepared for each course of study approved by the Board of Education in order to direct and assist the professional staff toward the attainment of goals addressed by that course of study. Each course guide shall contain objectives of the course of study and concepts and skills to be taught. The course guides shall be the basic instructional tool for each course of study. Each teacher shall conduct the course of study as required by the course guide. Deviations from the content of the guide must be approved by the principal in advance. The Superintendent shall be responsible for the preparation of course guides, and shall develop a plan for such preparation which includes the participation of appropriate staff members and resource personnel; the participation of members of the community; continuing research in instructional methods, materials, and activities; systematic review of all course guides to insure their continuing usefulness in achieving goals set by the Board; and a system of administrative review to insure that course guides are being followed by teaching staff members to the degree of conformity desired by this Board.

Whenever new course guides are developed or existing guides revised, copies of these additions or changes must be made available to the Board for review. The Board retains the right to reject any additions, changes and deletions to the presently approved course guides.
