Creating Positions

CREATING POSITIONS

The Board of Education recognizes its authority to establish positions that, when filled by qualified teaching staff members, will assist the district in the achievement of educational goals set by the Board. The Board shall create new positions as they are required, review a job description for each position that is clearly descriptive of the duties for which the position was created, approve a job title that conforms to the certification appropriate to the position, and specify the number of positions required to staff adequately each employment category. In the event the title of a newly created position is not recognized in rules of the State Board of Education, the Board will submit a written request for permission to use the proposed title to the County Superintendent for determination of the appropriate certification qualifying a person to fill the position. The Superintendent shall recommend to the Board such new positions or additions to existing employment categories as may be required by pupil enrollments and the educational needs of the district.
