Pupil Use of Bicycles**

### **PUPIL USE OF BICYCLES**

The Board of Education regards the use of bicycles for travel to and from school by pupils as an assumption of responsibility by those pupils--responsibility in the care of property, the observation of safety rules, and the display of courtesy and consideration toward others.

The Board will permit the use of bicycles by pupils in grades 4-8 in accordance with district rules provided that such pupils present written parental approval, have been granted permission by the building principal, and are not be bused to school.

The Board will not permit the use of mini-bikes or mopeds for pupil travel to and from school. The Board will not be responsible for bicycles that are lost, stolen, or damaged.

The principal may revoke a pupil's permit to operate a bicycle on school grounds for failure to observe district rules.
