Use of School

USE OF SCHOOL BUILDINGS

It is the policy of the Board of Education that the school facilities be made available for community use so long as such functions do not infringe upon normal school activities. Permission to use these facilities must be obtained from the proper authority and such use will be subject to the rules pertaining thereto.

School use shall be restricted to nonprofit group use only. Preferential consideration will be afforded civic and charitable organizations, but not to the exclusion of other duly organized groups who wish to use the facilities for fund raising. The Board will not permit the use of the building for regular religious services.

The Board prohibits the possession and consumption of an alcoholic beverage, without the express written permission of the Superintendent, and the possession and use of any controlled dangerous substance by any person in any school building and on any school property owned by this Board. The Board will report to law enforcement officials and prosecute as appropriate any person who violates law and this policy; any pupil under the influence of a controlled dangerous substance will be treated in accordance with Board policy and law.

The Superintendent shall develop regulations for the use of school facilities; such regulations shall be distributed to every user of the facilities and every applicant for the use of school facilities. No person or organization shall be granted permission to use School facilities who has not agreed in writing to be bound by those regulations.
